

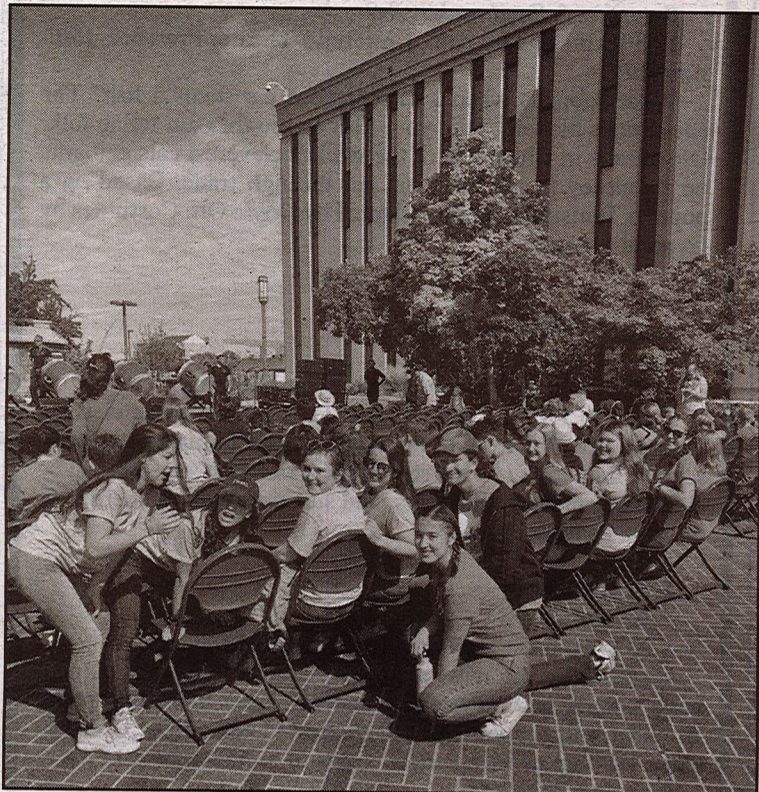

Piedmont Choirs' Ecco group returns from Utah tour

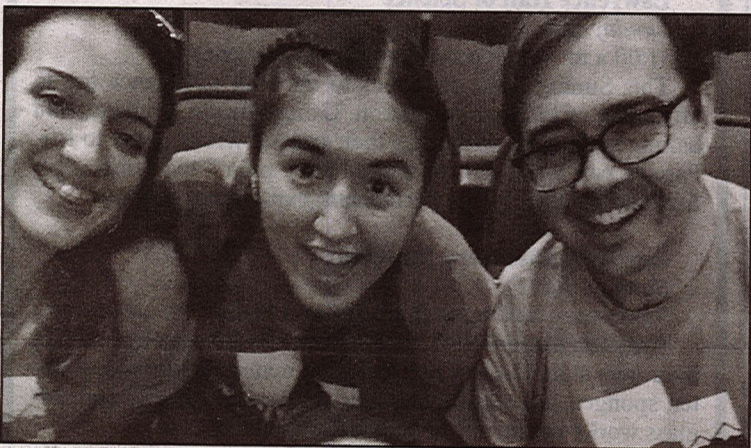
