

2019 TOUR PACKING LIST

Ensemble

Tour members are required to wear concert or tour clothing as listed below at all times while they are touring or traveling in public. One or two “civilian” outfits to wear while you are in homestays should be adequate. Please remember to pack lightly - because of limited bus space, we do not have room for oversized or large hard-sided bags. And you will need to handle your luggage yourself.

1 **SMALL** suitcase (no garment bags)
1 backpack
5 TOUR T-shirts (to be issued)
1 CHOIR jacket (to be issued if you do not already have one)
2-3 pair concert black dress socks
1 pair concert black shoes—either ballet slipper or jazz shoe
1 Concert cobalt blue long-sleeved shirt
1 black Concert jazz pants (boys) / Harem pants (girls)
3-4 white CHOIR polo shirts**
2 pair CHOIR navy shorts (minimum inseam 6-7")*
1 Ensemble/Choir navy sweatshirt
1-2 pair dark blue denim regulation jeans (no holes, not frayed or decorated)
8 or more pair all white sport socks
1-2 pair predominantly WHITE sport/tennis shoes
Underclothes (girls, be sure you have white or flesh-colored undergarments under your polo shirts!)
Bathing suit (sandals)
Sleepwear
1 daypack/string bag/purse to use on day excursions to avoid carrying a heavy backpack
Hat/cap/visor for sun
Rain poncho (to be issued)
WATER BOTTLE (refillable bottle must be empty when going through airport security)
Music & pencil
Toilet articles: soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb/brush, shampoo, sunscreen, antibacterial gel or hand-wipes, chapstick, throat lozenges, feminine supplies, etc.
Medications: Label with singer's name, name of medicine, and directions. Provide an extra set for staff.

Optional:

Wristwatch – to keep track of time
Inexpensive camera with charger/adaptor (2 round prongs--“C” or “F”)
Small flashlight
Ensemble sweatpants
Umbrella

Homestay gifts (2 families). Suggestions for small items to present to host families: CD's, T-shirts or hats, any souvenir items from California – notecards, calendars, books featuring our local area.

Spending money (Suggest \$50-150, depending on your shopping needs.) Turn it in to Choir office **by June 11th** if you wish to have money held by the chaperones and converted to Euro as necessary.
